<b>Job profile</b>	<p>The study nurse (round the clock shift duties) will be responsible for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pre-screening of all mothers for eligibility</li> <li>• Taking consent from eligible mothers</li> <li>• Giving all information about study to parents/Guardians and to explore whether they are interested in participating in the study</li> <li>• Sample collection from mother before delivery (rectovaginal swabs and blood sample), sample collection at the time of delivery (cord blood, cord tissue, vernix)</li> <li>• To fill CRF form for all enrolled mothers and neonates</li> <li>• To monitor the babies for occurrence of sepsis</li> <li>• To collect blood samples, urine, stool, oral and nasopharyngeal swab in neonates with suspect sepsis</li> <li>• To collect breast milk sample from enrolled mothers in the postnatal wards</li> <li>• To follow all the neonates till discharge or 28 days of life whichever is greater</li> <li>• must be able to evaluate the material and work effectively with other researchers</li> <li>• Data collection</li> <li>• To coordinate with lab personnel to transport and process the samples from NICU to the NICU side lab and microbiology lab</li> <li>• Collection of lab results and coordinating with RO for final labelling of sepsis</li> <li>• Coordinate with RO for smooth flow of CRFs.</li> </ul>
